

PANEL GUIDELINES MDA Member's Discretionary Fund

Purpose

The purpose of this fund is to provide discretionary grants for individuals with a neuromuscular condition (*covered by the MDA) to access opportunities and specialised resources that enable them to achieve freedom beyond limits.

Eligibility to Apply

- Applicant has a neuromuscular condition (*covered by the MDA)
- Applicant is a registered member of the MDA
- Applicant is applying on behalf of a Rangatahi or Tamariki member
- Government funding is not available
- Prospective application falls within 3 months of closing date
- Where application is for retrospective refund, event must have been within 3 months of closing date
- Requests for therapies of an ongoing nature are out of scope for this discretionary fund

Goodness of Fit

- Effectiveness of opportunity or resource has been demonstrated (e.g. creatine monohydrate versus fish oil supplements for a person living with Duchenne muscular dystrophy)
- Risk of harm, either to the individual, or the MDA (including reputational harm)
- Consistency with MDA vision, mission and values

Affordability

- MDA has funds available
- One off purchase versus ongoing expenses (panel to consider ethical implications of funding something one year, but not the next)
- Ability of the applicant to make up the difference when the application is for partial funding limitations (panel to consider 3 month timeframe)
- Consider whether previous funding has been provided by MDA and whether the individual fulfilled their obligations

• The individual has explained what the opportunity or resource will do to enhance their life or support them to achieve freedom beyond limits.
